

Mifflin Borough Council met in a regular session on November 2, 2020 at 7:00 PM in the Borough office in Mifflin, PA. President David Cisney conducted the meeting with the following members in attendance: Randy Foose, Lesa Kramer, Sam Stine, George Berrier, Joe Long, and Janet Wyland.

**MINUTES:** On motion of Foose and J. Long, Council voted to approved the ammedbed minutes from the October 5th meeting. Faulkraods will need to be added to the minutes in October under bids that were received.

**VISITORS:** Bob, a resident living on Main Street, said someone is parking in front of his diveway. Officer Andrew Bustin is going to address the issue. He said that he has issued several citations on Main Street. Fern Harling said someone is parking in the handicapped spot. Sam will paint the curb or the handicapped spot.

**MAYOR'S REPORT:** Wyland said that the Tax assessor needs address and contact information for President, VP, and secretary.

**HEALTH & WELFARE:** Stine requested Officer Bustin be at monthly meetings to address parking and other police issues that may arise. Bustin was making suggestions on a getting an additional officer. Andrew mentioned Language Line to help with translating. Bustin also mentioned that Microsoft needs a credit card to update on the computer in the Police office. Foose will discuss with Amber. On motion of J. Long and Stine, Council approved to open a police account to deposit incoming payments for citations. Council will be meeting with potential new officer.

**BUILDING & STREETS:** Stine said there is a residen in the alley behind Summit street that has an extension cord running from their house across the alley to their garage. Faulk roads will be paving Frank St on November 3rd.

**RECREATION:** Bathrooms at the ballfield have been winterized.

**SOLID WASTE:** Council called the Mifflintown Borough Council at 7:11pm to award a contractor for the garbage contract. On motion of Stine and Berrier, Council approved Cocalamus Creek Dosposal for a 5-year joint garbage contract with Mifflintown Borough to begin January 1, 2021. The agreement is for weekly pickup of 5 bags. The borough has a surplus in the garbage account. On motion of Foose and Stine, Council approved to pay 1st quarter garbage bills for all residents that are NOT past due by January 1, 2021. Kristy Cisney took delinquent garbage accounts to solicitor, Don Zagurskie that would be up referred for Sheriff Sale. Council must approve the solicitor to move forward. On motion of Stine and Foose, Council approved to Sheriff Sale residents Terry Coder and Daniel Earnest for delinquent garbage payments.

**BUDGET & FINANCE:** Final budget workshop on November 16th. Budget approval will be added to the agenda for December.
