The Borough has also added a hoverboard ordinance that doesn't allow riding on the road. Chapter 15, Part 7, Section 703. Moion by Foose and Long to have the ordinance added.

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**R \*ECREATION:** Checked prices for dirt for baseball field, Bathrooms at field had a copper line break, it has been fixed. Softball association wants the borough to pay for broken wood O\*/pieces at the pavilion.

**/SOLID WASTE:** Fire Dept has received 3 bills for garbage. They have a dumpster so the borough will be disregarding their bills. Request IDs from people using the dumpsters for clean up. Danny Earnest daughter would like him to be put on a payment plan of \$80 per month to catch garbage bills up. Borough declines. Sheriff sale sticks. Don has suggested doing multiple steps at the same time for outstanding garbage bills. Motion by Long and Stine to make this a 3 step process instead of a 4 step process.
