

November 2021

Mifflin Borough Council met in a regular session on October 4th , 2021 at 7:00 PM in the Mifflin Borough Building in Mifflin, PA. President Randy Foose conducted the meeting with the following members in attendance: Sam Stine, George Berrier, and Janet Wyland.

MINUTES: On motion of Foose and Stine, Council voted to approve the minutes from the August 2nd meeting.

VISITORS: Thelma Rowles attended the meeting regarding the hole in her sidewalk due to water backing up in her basement. Cisney and Foose explained that it is scheduled, but we have to wait until the guy is available. Cisney mentioned that it is very difficult to find a contractor, especially on short notice.

MAYOR'S REPORT: Nothing to report.

HEALTH & WELFARE: Nothing to report.

BUILDING & STREETS: Council discussed fines for code enforcement officer. On motion from Stine and Berrier, Council approved the the amended fines as listed under Resolution 1 for Code Enforcement. North Street is too wide causing resulting in the paving estimate being significantly more than other streets. Council agrees to just have the street wide enough for 2 cars. On motion from Foose and Stine, Council approved the posting of the ad to seek bids for North Street paving based on new reduced volume once Matt Kenepf provides new estimate. Posting will be in Juniata Sentinel and Lewistown Sentinel. Pedestrian Bridge has two lights out. Cisney will check around for someone to replace them. Since it's been confirmed that Luid Fuels money along with Turnback money can be used for paving alleys that the Borough is responsible for, Council discussed Patterson Lane, Eshleman Lane, and Mifflin Street being paved. Council concerned about limited time for completing this year. Council agreed to table paving these streets until the Spring.

RECREATION: The Borough will be receiving a \$18,000 COVID grant for new playground equipment. The equipment that was quoted in June 2020 for the grant, will take up a big portion of the playground. On motion from Stine and Berrier, Council approved to purchase Play Structure and Unity Rocker from the equipment estimate received in June 2020.

SOLID WASTE: The dumpster used by the Conservation Committee is still sitting on River Road. Council will have Andrew issue citation to CCD for obstructing traffics and have it removed.

BUDGET & FINANCE: There is money with the county that the Borough has encumbered for several years. County Commissioner said that the Borough can not encumber another year. On Motion from Foose and Stine, Council voted to use the encumbered money to help pay for

North Street paving. At the October meeting, Council will vote to post budget pending any additional updates/changes.

OLD BUSINESS: Cisney and Stine signed new plans for land to be transferred to Stine. .

NEW BUSINESS: There's been confusion with receiving multiple invoices/statements And not knowing what they are for. All bills, invoices, and statements will need to be approved prior to being paid. Stine mentioned that every council member should have a code book, or at least access to one. Stine will get with Karen to see if she can get Codes/ordinance book in order.

CORRESPONDENCE: Nothing to report.

APPROVE BILLS: On Motion from Foose and Stine, Council approved to pay any outstanding bills as listed on the agenda. Going forward, all bills will be individually reviewed and approved.

On Motion from Foose and Stine, Council entered executive session.

On Motion from Stine and Berrier, Council exited executive session.

ADJOURN: On Motion from Stine and Berrier, Council adjourned at 8:22 pm.
